

WAKAW LAKE REGIONAL PARK

Campground Rules

Welcome to Wakaw Lake Regional Park. We hope your stay with us is an enjoyable experience! In order to provide a safe and pleasant camping experience for everyone, we ask that you please adhere to the following rules:

- All campers in a site must be a minimum of 19 years of age unless accompanied by parents/guardians
- One camping unit per site – one small additional tent may be set up
- QUIET TIME is 11pm – No one is permitted on the beach after 11pm
- There is NO entry into the park after quiet time. After hours, registered campers may call security
- Security is on premises at all times day and night. There is a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY! Abuse of any kind will NOT be tolerated (physical/verbal). Security will evict if needed with no refund.
- Pets are allowed in the park but: MUST NEVER BE IN A CAMPER OR CAMPSITE UNATTENDED, if you leave the park for any reason your pet must go as well. Barking will not be tolerated, respect other campers space, others may not welcome your pet. All pets must be secured by a leash AT ALL TIMES and the leash must be controlled by a person capable of restraining the animal. Virtual/electronic leashes/fences are not permitted. No animals are permitted on the beach at any time. Clean up after your pet, Mutt Mitt dispensers are located in C-camp, D-camp and boat launch. Campers with aggressive dogs will be asked to leave. Failure to comply with these rules may result in eviction with no refund. Report any problems to the Front Gate or Security.
- Responsible alcohol use is permitted within the park in private campsites only, not on roadways or public areas. Alcohol is prohibited to minors. Noisy parties, loud music or disturbances will NOT be tolerated. Following one warning violators will be escorted from the park grounds by security and the RCMP. No refund
- ABSOLUTELY NO fireworks allowed.
- Anyone operating a golf cart must have a valid drivers license. Do not hang off the back or sides of carts. Each golf cart operating within the park must display a Park Licence Plate Sticker for the current year – available at the Golf Pro-shop.
- Check out time is 12 Noon sharp. If you want a late check out you may pay a fee of \$10, subject to availability.
- If Park Management should become aware of dangerous weather conditions, a siren located on the clubhouse roof will sound. Please take proper precautions in the event of any inclement weather conditions. The park has an emergency evacuation plan in effect. You will be directed by park staff should this be necessary.
