Welcome to Golf



On behalf of the Wakaw Lake Golf Course with the assistance of the National Golf Course Owners Association of Canada (NGCOA) we'd like to invite you to participate in the first ever open house to assist new and beginner golfers to feel more comfortable with booking tee times as well as the etiquette surrounding the game of golf. We know it can be daunting to new golfers but it's relatively easy to learn, and new golfers can enjoy the purpose of the game which is to "have fun and socialize".

On Thursday, May 25th golf course personal will be on hand to assist participants to learn this great game. There will be two sessions where golfers will be taught the basics of golf which include: booking a tee time and arrival at the course, practice putting on the green and etiquette around the green while putting, driving net use and club selection, a tour of the course and instruction on proper manners on the course.

BOOKING A TEE TIME: Participants will be instructed on what is a tee time, using the Tee-on golf system, arriving at the course preparing for your tee time, how many golfers can play in a group, renting clubs and a cart, dress code, and food and beverage purchase.

PUTTING GREEN ETIQUETTE: Using the practice green next to the 1st tee, golfers will receive information on marking their ball, order of play, removal and replacement of the pin, ensuring shadows aren't a distraction, and silence while fellow golfers are putting. Everyone will be supplied with a putter and given time to practice their putts.

PRACTICE NETS: Next to the putting green are newly installed driving nets where golfers are able to practice prior to their tee time or any time they're open. Golfers will learn the proper method of teeing their golf ball, order of play as well as club selection. Each golfer will be given an opportunity to tee golf balls and hit several practice shots with instruction from experienced golfers.

COURSE TOUR AND ETIQUETTE: Using power carts provided by the golf course, a tour of the course will be led by a volunteer who will describe the course layout, order of play, pace of play, score keeping and repairing damage to the course by golfers.

THE CROOKED CLUB - CLUBHOUSE & SOCIAL BAR: Complimentary non-alcoholic beverages will be provided during the open house to registered participants.

There will be two sessions during the day with the first being from 1pm to 3pm and the second from 6pm to 8pm. We ask that you pre-register for this event by calling the pro shop at 306-233-5955. Come out and have some fun!
