



2024 RESERVATION DRAW INFORMATION

Monthly Reservation Draw for rental of non-permanent sites

Stay one month or longer - submit an application for random draw to take place in late April. The draw allows campers renting for one month or longer to have priority choice of campsites before general reservations begin on May 1st. Draw applicants **are not guaranteed** a site – the draw only determines the order for choice of a campsite.

If you do not know your preferred campsite, we will help you choose one when we call you after the draw. **DO NOT PROVIDE CREDIT CARD INFORMATION UNTIL YOU ARE CALLED AND HAVE CONFIRMED SITE SELECTION.**

The Park is offering a bonus to clients who wish to book for the entire 5-month stay. The 5th month rental fee will be charged at the two-week fee of \$530.00 rather than the monthly fee of \$882.00 for a saving of \$352.00 for our long-term clients. – Based on 30-amp full-service site. (50-amp site will be \$562.00 rather than \$938.00 for a saving of 376.00)

Daily, Weekly, & Monthly rental of non-permanent sites

The Park opens at 8:00 a.m. on May 1st. We accept reservations for daily, weekly, and monthly camping at 306 233-5744 or in person at the gate.

Seasonal (permanent) Sites

The Park has 168 permanent sites that are licensed to use on a continuous basis.

143 out of 168 permanent sites are assignable by the current occupant – their use may be permanently given/sold to another person. Access to an assignable site is by private arrangement with the occupant and with subsequent approval of the park.

The remaining 25 permanent sites are non-assignable and are subject to a wait list from the park office. Please contact the park administrator by email to check if new names are being added to the wait list. info@wakawlakerp.ca

Monthly Camping Draw

This draw makes it possible for customers who wish to reserve a campsite for a period of one month (30 days) or greater to reserve a site prior to the May 1 opening of the park. Monthly campsites can still be reserved upon the opening of the park at 8:00 am on May 1st but the selection will be limited.

The Draw has the advantages of relieving some of the congestion at the gate on May 1; providing a fair system of assigning sites for those who are unable to attend at the gate on May 1; accommodating better choice of sites for those who are seeking a long stay in the park.

The elements of this monthly draw system are as follows:

Reservation requests will be accepted at any time prior to 5:00 pm.

FRIDAY, APRIL 12, 2024. A reservation request form is available at the front gate prior to Park closing September 30. The updated form will be available on our website after December 1st at www.wakawlakeregionalpark.ca

Following April 12th all requests will be opened and sorted into four categories by duration of stay requested.

- A. *Four to five months (121 to 150 days)*
- B. *Three to four months (91 to 120 days)*
- C. *Two to three months (61 to 90 days)*
- D. *One to two months (30 to 60 days)*

Reservation requests will be selected by blind draw from each of the four categories, starting with category A. *Four to five months*. Requests will be marked in order of the draw and bookings will occur in that order. Once booking is completed in category A, requests will be drawn from category B, and so on to finish with Category D.

Each request should contain necessary telephone numbers to ensure contact when booking. If we are not able to contact someone in the order of the draw, we will proceed with booking the next person in order and try back again later.

In the situation where you change your mind and want fewer days than applied for, your application will be returned to the appropriate group and drawn at that time.

Please be aware that if you are booked for a longer stay than you intend to use and pull out early during the summer, we reserve the right to reject your application for the following years draw.

Also, please note that it will take some time to process the requests following the draw. In 2024, we anticipate contacting entries from Categories A & B starting on April 20, 2024 and entries from categories C & D on or before April 22, 2024.
